Renewal of Milne Point Pipeline Right-of-Way Lease, ADL 410221

Milne Point Pipeline, LLC filed an application for the renewal of the Milne Pipeline Right-of-Way Lease in the Prudhoe Bay area. The State Pipeline Coordinator's Office (SPCO) is coordinating the State of Alaska's review of the lease renewal for consistency with the Alaska Coastal Management Program, and requests your written comments, particularly on the lease renewal's consistency with the North Slope Borough Coastal Management Program. To be considered, SPCO must receive written comments before **5:00 p.m. on August 22, 2002** (contact information below). Comments regarding inconsistency with an affected coastal district's enforceable policy or a state standard set out in 6 AAC 80.040 thru 6 AAC 80.150 must identify the enforceable policy or standard and explain how the renewal of the lease is inconsistent.

NAME OF LEASE/NUMBER: Renewal of Milne Point Pipeline Right-of-Way Lease, ADL 410221

APPLICANT/PROPOSED LEASE RENEWAL: The Milne Point Pipeline, LLC requests to renew the Milne Point Pipeline Right-of-Way Lease across State lands for the maximum term of 30 years allowed by law. The right-of-way originates at Milne Point Unit Central Facilities Pad and terminates at a tie-in to the Kuparuk Transportation System in the Prudhoe Bay Unit on the North Slope, traversing state land as described in Alaska State Land Survey No. 84-114. The following is a general description of the state lands that are requested for renewal of the right-of-way lease and all lands are within the Umiat Meridian:

Sections 5, and 8, Township 11 North, Range 11 East
Sections 6, 7, 8, 17, 19, 20, 30, 31, and 32, Township 12 North, Range 11 East
Sections 24, 25, and 36, Township 13 North, Range 10 East
