

**AMENDMENT OF THE RIGHT-OF-WAY LEASE  
FOR THE  
TRANS-ALASKA PIPELINE  
ADL 63574**

This is an Amendment to Exhibit D Description of the Right-of-Way for Related Facilities of the RIGHT-OF-WAY LEASE FOR THE TRANS-ALASKA PIPELINE dated May 3, 1974, ADL 63574, which was recorded in the Fairbanks Recording District in Book 149 Pages 0799 through 0905 on July 16, 1979, hereinafter referred to as AMENDMENT. This AMENDMENT is made and entered into and becomes effective this 5<sup>th</sup> day of March, 1996 by and between the STATE OF ALASKA located at 411 West 4th Avenue, Suite 2C, Anchorage, Alaska 99501 acting through the Commissioner of Natural Resources hereinafter referred to as COMMISSIONER, and Alyeska Pipeline Service Company as agent for Amerada Hess Pipeline Corporation, ARCO Transportation Alaska, Inc., BP Pipelines (Alaska) Inc., Exxon Pipeline Company, Mobile Alaska Pipeline Company, Phillips Alaska Pipeline Corporation, and Unocal Pipeline Company located at 1835 South Bragaw Street, Mailstop-569, Anchorage, Alaska 99512 hereinafter referred to as LESSEE.

WHEREAS, the LESSEE has applied to amend the existing Right-of-Way Lease ADL 63574 to include additional shoreland within the Fairbanks Recording District for the purpose of constructing and maintaining a new diversion dike that extends from the pipeline right-of-way at pipeline milepost (PLMP) 243.6 into the Middle Fork Koyukuk River floodplain. The purpose of the diversion dike is to control river bank erosion and protect the Trans-Alaska Pipeline System (TAPS) by preventing the development of an active river channel over the buried pipeline at this location. The diversion dike will be situated within the SW4SE4 of Section 1, of Township 27 North, Range 13 West, Fairbanks Meridian, Alaska. The shoreland requested for construction of the dike consists of approximately 2.3 acres.

NOW THEREFORE, the COMMISSIONER and LESSEE agree to amend the RIGHT-OF-WAY FOR THE TRANS-ALASKA PIPELINE, ADL 63574 to include the shorelands described as:

Township 27 North, range 13 West, Fairbanks, Meridian, Alaska.

Section 1, SW4SE4, those lands below the ordinary high water mark of the Middle Fork Koyukuk River within the following described area:

Beginning at a point on the westerly TAP right-of-way boundary line opposite pipeline station 12863 + 88, the point of beginning; thence southwesterly along the westerly TAP right-of-way boundary line a distance of 200 feet to a point; thence northwesterly at right angles to the previous bearing a distance of approximately 335 feet to a point; thence northeasterly at right angles to the previous bearing a distance of approximately 400 feet to a point; thence southeasterly at right angles to the previous bearing a distance of approximately 335 feet to a point on the westerly boundary line of the TAP right-of-way; thence southwesterly along the westerly

TAP right-of-way boundary line a distance of 200 feet to the point of beginning, containing approximately 2.3 acres.


Located within the Fairbanks Recording District

The land described above are incorporated into and made a part of the RIGHT-OF-WAY LEASE FOR THE TRANS-ALASKA PIPELINE dated May 3, 1974, ADL 63574. This AMENDMENT shall be consummated after the issuance of the Notice to Proceed, construction and review/acceptance of the as-built survey for the diversion dike, said as-built to be tied to the pipeline centerline.


